The Plenary Council – An Invitation

We are now moving into the final four weeks of the ‘Listening and Dialogue’ phase of the Plenary Council.

In the eight months since the Listening and Dialogue period commenced at Pentecost, more than 40,000 people have either made a submission or participated in a group discussion that culminated in a submission.

(This includes members of our parish, whom submitted responses after our session last year.)

Plenary Council president Archbishop Timothy Costelloe SDB has said *“...weeks from the end of this pivotal opening phase, it is both exciting and humbling to have heard from such large numbers of people and for them to have shared their stories of faith and hope, but also their stories of despair and heartbreak.*

Each of those stories is valuable and meaningful.

So will be the stories we receive between now and Ash Wednesday.”
