

We encourage you to participate in other ways -

- Reflecting on and praying with the Scriptures (particularly the [Mass readings](#))
- Making a Stations of the Cross
- Praying the Rosary
- Making an Act of Spiritual Communion

## **How can I participate in Mass online?**

Despite our current limitations, we can still participate in the celebration of Mass online thanks to modern technology. Many dioceses around the world provide online streaming of Masses, including our own Archdiocese of Melbourne. Below are some links to online Masses. We also encourage you to think about how you might help those home-bound and less tech-savvy to be able to access Mass online during this time.

1. **St Patrick's Cathedral, Melbourne** Mass at St Patrick's Cathedral, Melbourne is available dai-

ly. The 1pm Mass is streamed live daily (Mon-Fri) and is then available as a recording on-demand until one hour prior to the next Mass. Sunday Mass is available, with the 11am Mass live streamed and it is also available as a recording on-demand. <https://melbournecatholic.org.au/Mass>

2. **Pope Francis' daily Mass** Pope Francis' daily Masses are now available online through the Vatican's website and YouTube channel. They are expected to continue to be available throughout the upcoming weeks. <https://www.vaticannews.va/en/pope-francis/mass-casa-santa-marta.pagelist.html>

3. **Mass for You at Home** This program has been allowing the faithful - particularly those with mobility problems - to participate in Mass from their homes for many years. Mass for You at Home is broadcast on Eleven and Network Ten on Sundays and Aurora Channel on Foxtel every day. ## **Please remember to:**

- Maintain social distancing at all times.
- Entry to the church is via the left side door through the cloisters.
- The Chapel is closed.
- There is hand sanitiser in the narthex near the glass doors to the church, if you would like to use it.
- Please follow the arrows marked on the floor.
- Seating - X marks the spot. It is preferred that you sit in the spaces marked.

- Communion - please stay where you are and Father will come to you.
- EXIT is via the door opposite the entry - follow the arrows on the floor. Please maintain social distancing when exiting the church.
- If you are unwell, please do not come.

We are still only permitted to have 20 people attend Mass, plus the minimum number of people reasonably required to perform the service. Bookings are still required.

## What are the penalties for Noncompliance of the current government restrictions?

Victoria Police can issue on the spot fines of up to \$1,652 for individuals and up to \$9,913 for businesses:

- Refusing or failing to comply with the emergency directions
- Refusing or failing to comply with a public health risk power direction
- Refusing or failing to comply with a direction by the Deputy Chief Health Officer to provide information.

Fines of up to \$20,000 for individuals and \$100,000 for businesses are possible through the court system.



Alternatively, Cash or cheque donations can be left at the parish office.
